“Online training course of multipliers for Global Peace”

- ...You are between 18 and 30 years old, active in youth work or peace work in your community, interested to learn more about peace, sustainability and other globally important topics?
- ...You want to share the experiences from your community, learn more about local situation in different countries and to get to know people from different continents?
- ...You have a good level of English?

Then, apply until 20th of January 2023 for the online/hybrid training course (see your contact person on page 2).

What we offer:

- International trainers will train you during a 7-days online (hybrid) training in United Nations SDGs, peace and sustainability topics, in usage of different media tools.
- You will get to know 20 youth activists from Uganda, South Sudan, Georgia and Germany and share information on the local situations.
- You can select interesting topics for you and prepare your own presentation.
- If you participate in at least 80% of the course, you will receive a **certificate** by act for transformation.
- Afterwards you can be involved in our activities on global education as a multiplier.

Follow Up:

- From April until July we will organize 6 to 8 online / hybrid joint events with local activists on peace and sustainability topics important for the communities.
- On 21st of September, UN Global Peace Day local groups will organize a Peace Day in their community.
